Small class size with **only one student per workstation** allows the instructor to coach each student over-the-shoulder. Instead of pre-canned scripted labs, each hands-on exercise presents realistic tasks which require the student to recognize problems and then to systematically work out solutions. This class effectively develops the **problem-solving skills** which other training methods neglect.

Although this is not intended to be a programming class, it makes an extremely effective “first step” course for students who plan to become programmers. This course provides in-depth coverage of how the PLC handles field inputs and outputs, and a step-by-step analysis of the processor’s scan cycle. These are critical concepts required for effective programming.
